References:

- The line dotted thus — shows the limits of the Rail Road Reservation.
- This kind of a shade defines the boundaries of the principal bodies of Swamp and overflowed Lands.
- Townships marked F are those now under Contract or order for resurvey.
- Indicates Townships surveyed by Chas. R. Peltum, which are estimated for resurvey.
- This indicates Townships recommended for resurvey by Sar. Gen. Gibson, or Milbourne, but not yet contracted for.
- Indicates Townships surveyed under Surveyors Gen. Gibson, Milbourne and Rector up to date.
- This marks a Township or on an exterior boundary designates those of which the field notes have been copied and sent to the Gen. Land Office.
- This marks that they are copied but not sent.
- Map of the Arkansas surveying district showing the extent of public surveys in said district on the 13th of Oct. 1855.
- The surveyed exteriors are indicated by black lines, the subdivided Townships by the letter S.
- Townships marked G indicate those in which are detected erroneous surveys, or fragments of surveys incomplete, and also those recommended for resurvey or retrace-ment.
- Townships marked D are those, the returns of which have been received, examined and approved, and plots prepared and transmitted to the Register and Commissioner.
- Townships and lines marked R indicate those in which the field notes have been recorded.

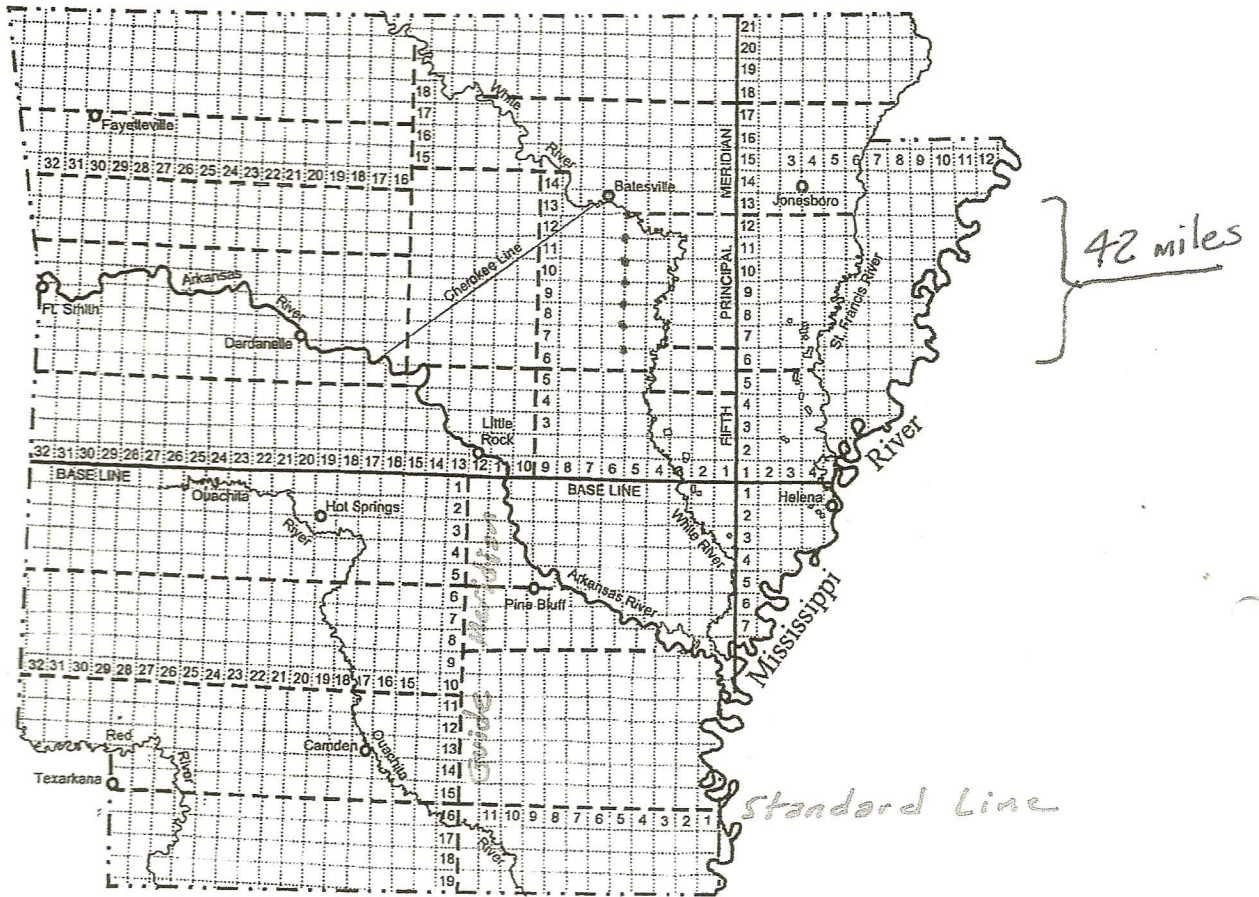
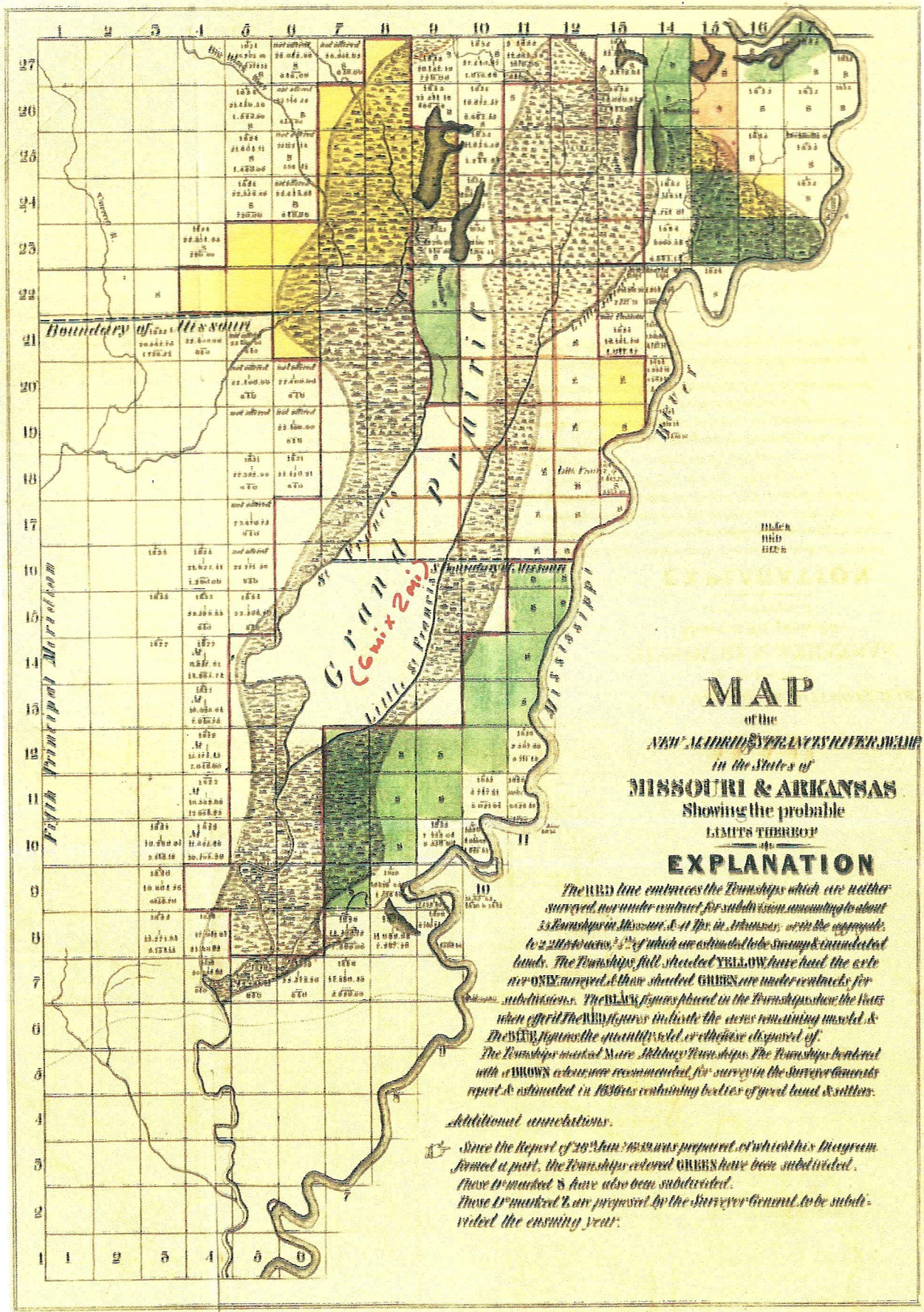

EXPLANATION

The RED line embraces the Townships which are neither surveyed nor under contract for subdivision amounting to about 25 Townships in the west & 41 Twp. in Arkansas, or to the aggregate of 2,200,000 acres, 2/3 of which are estimated to be swamp & inundated lands. The Townships still shaded YELLOW have had the entire or one surveyed & those shaded GREEN are under contracts for subdivisions. The BLACK figures placed in the Townships show the acres when offered. The RED figures indicate the acres remaining unsold & the BLUE figures the quantity sold or otherwise disposed of. The Townships marked STATE ATTORNEY TOWNSHIPS. The Townships bounded with a BROWN colour were recommended for survey in the Surveyor General's report & patented in 1836 as containing bodies of good land & settlers.

Additional annotations.

Since the report of 26th Jan: 1839 was prepared of which this Diagram formed a part, the Townships colored GREEN have been subdivided. Those marked S have also been subdivided. Those marked L are proposed by the Surveyor General to be subdivided the ensuing year.
